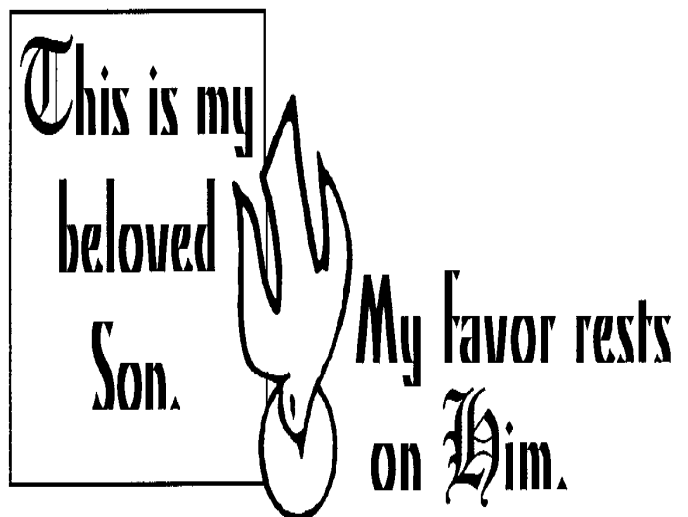

MUERTE Y VIDA NUEVA

Hoy recordamos el bautismo de Jesús y nos preguntamos, Realmente Jesús necesitaba el bautismo? Sabemos firmemente que NO lo necesitaba, es por esto la resistencia de San Juan Bautista a realizar el bautismo a Cristo, pero Jesús lo convence “*Es necesario para que cumplamos lo que Dios quiere*”

Esto es lo central del mensaje HACER LO QUE DIOS QUIERE.

Ahora es un agua regeneradora, pues esta unida a la acción del Espíritu Santo, pues en el evangelio de San Juan dice: “El que no nace del agua y del Espíritu, no puede entrar en el Re-

ino de Dios.

Ahora el bautismo nos confiere por medio de Jesucristo una nueva naturaleza, nos hace co-herederos con Cristo y Ciudadanos del Cielo. Pregunto... Que mas podemos pedir?

Con el bautismo Jesús inicia su ministerio salvifico, es por esto que el profeta Isaías menciona las características de el Mesías, y esto es así, porque el mismo bautismo cristiano imprime un carácter nuevo en nuestra vida, esto es un misterio maravilloso que debemos ahondar.
