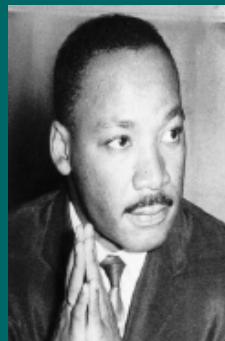

*To commemorate Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, here is a passage from Church documents on his life and work. This passage is from Pope John Paul II's address at the Meeting with the Black Catholic Community of New Orleans in 1987.*

"Even in this wealthy nation, committed by its Founding Fathers to the dignity and equality of all persons, the black community suffers a disproportionate share of economic deprivation. Far too many of your young people receive less than an equal opportunity for a quality education and for gainful employment. The Church must continue to join her efforts with the efforts of others who are working to correct all imbalances and disorders of a social nature. Indeed, the Church can never remain silent in the face of injustice, wherever it is clearly present.

In the most difficult hours of your struggle for civil rights amidst discrimination and oppression, God himself guided your steps along the way of peace. Before the witness of history the response of non-violence stands, in the memory of this nation, as a monument of honour to the black community of the United States. Today as we recall those who with Christian vision opted for non-violence as the only truly effective approach for ensuring and safeguarding human dignity, we cannot but think of the Reverend Dr Martin Luther King, Jr, and of the providential role he played in contributing to the rightful human betterment of black Americans and therefore to the improvement of American society itself.

My dear brothers and sisters of the black community: it is the hour to give thanks to God for his liberating action in your history and in your lives. This liberating action is a sign and expression of Christ's Paschal Mystery, which in every age is effective in helping God's people to pass from bondage into their glorious vocation of full Christian freedom. And as you offer your prayer of thanksgiving, you must not fail to concern yourselves with the plight of your brothers and sisters in other places throughout the world. Black Americans must offer their own special solidarity of Christian love to all people who bear the heavy burden of oppression, whatever its physical or moral nature."

May these words, in commemoration of this man, be an inspiration of the significance we as Christians can impart upon our community and possibly the world.

### II DOMINGO ORDINARIO

#### ESTE ES EL CORDERO QUE QUITA EL PECADO

Dios llama a cada uno de nosotros desde el seno materno, El realmente quiere manifestar su Gloria en cada persona que viene a este mundo, solo que debemos ver cual es la Voluntad de Dios para nuestra vida.

Primero que nada, Dios quiere que seamos santos, quiere que nuestra vida sea una ofrenda permanente para El, Crees que es una locura? Pues no lo es.

El Evangelio nos presenta como Juan el Bautista proclama a Jesús con un lenguaje un poco extraño para nosotros: "Este es el Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo", palabras que repetimos en cada misa a la que asistimos pero que en muchas ocasiones no conocemos la profundidad de su significado.

El cordero era un animal que servía para el sacrificio, mediante los sacrificios rituales y holocaustos, los pecados de los judíos quedaban CUBIERTOS, mas no quitados, pues, de acuerdo a la Ley se decía, "Sin derramamiento de sangre NO hay perdón de los pecados. Así pues el pueblo buscaba la forma de ganarse el favor de Dios.

El A. T. es una sombra de lo que es la realidad del Nuevo Testamento, es por esto que se requería que viniera el Cristo, es decir el Mesías, para restaurar todas las cosas.

Solo mediante el sacrificio de Jesús en la cruz, nuestros pecados, no solo fueron perdonados, sino que la raíz principal el PECADO, quedo quitado, pues para eso vino el Hijo del Hombre, para deshacer las obras de las tinieblas,

mas aun, para que surgiera una nueva raza, un pueblo nuevo, constituido por la Alianza Nueva y Eterna.

Que realiza esta obra redentora de Jesús?

En la carta a los Corintios, San Pablo lo dice muy claramente: "A todos ustedes, a quienes Dios santifico en Cristo Jesús y que son su pueblo Santo, así como todos aquellos que invocan en cualquier lugar el nombre de Cristo Jesús" No te parece esto maravilloso? Somos un pueblo Santo, eso lo dice continuamente San Pablo, poco a poco iremos descubriendo ese llamado que Dios nos hace a ser santos, no es una opción, sino una NECESIDAD, para poder compartir las riquezas que Dios quiere para su pueblo, para ti y para mi.

Para poder ser limpiados, y ser así Templos del Espíritu Santo, que viene a realizar la obra de la perfección cristiana dentro de nosotros, pues esto es una obra interior, profunda, pero real, que nos hace personas nuevas.

Ser rociados con la sangre del Cordero es ser santificados, por tanto debes recordar que en cada Eucaristía, Jesús el cordero pascual se sacrifica para tu santificación y es por tanto necesario que te preguntes: Correspondo a la gracia de Dios, en este magno sacramento del amor divino?
