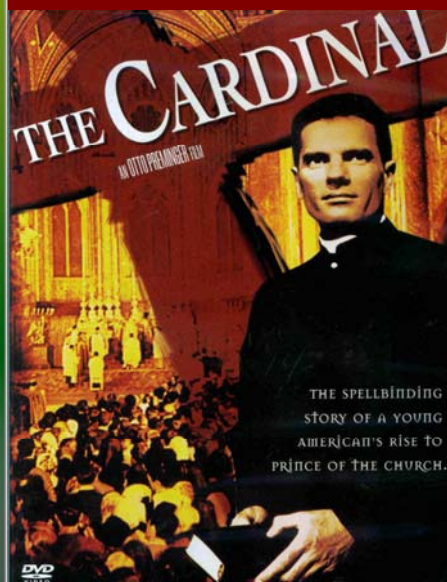

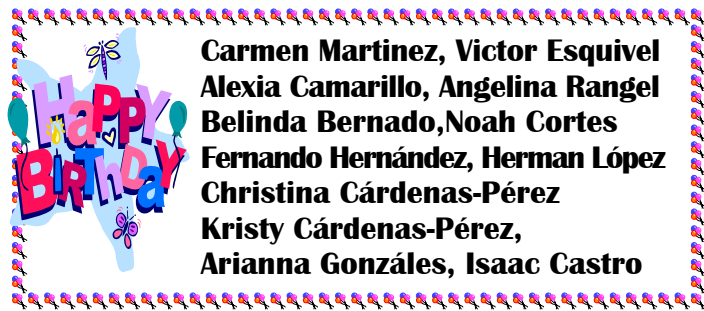

### ST. TERESA OF AVILA

Teresa was born in Avila, Spain, on March 28, 1515. As a little girl in her parents' rich home, Teresa and her brother Rodrigo loved to read the lives of the saints and martyrs. It seemed to them that the martyrs got to heaven an easy way. The two children set out secretly to go to the land of the Moors. As they walked along, they prayed that they might die for Christ. But they had not gotten far when they met an uncle. He took them back to their worried mother at once. Next the children decided to be hermits in their garden. This didn't work out either. They could not get enough stones together to build their huts. St. Teresa herself wrote down these amusing stories of her childhood. The fact is that when she grew to be a teenager, however, she changed. Teresa read so many novels and foolish romances that she lost much of her love for prayer. She began to think more of dressing up to look pretty. But after she recovered from a bad illness, Teresa read a book about the great St. Jerome. Then and there, she made up her mind to become a bride of Christ. As a nun, Teresa often found it hard to pray. Besides that, she had poor health. Teresa wasted time every day in long, foolish conversations. But one day, in front of a picture of Jesus, she felt great sorrow that she did not love God more. She started then to live for Jesus alone, no matter what sacrifice had to be made. In return for her love, the Lord gave St. Teresa the privilege of hearing him talk to her. She learned to pray in a marvelous way, too. St. Teresa of Avila is famous for having opened new Carmelite convents. These convents were filled with sisters who wanted to live holy lives. They made many sacrifices for Jesus. Teresa herself gave them the example. She prayed with great love and worked hard at the convent tasks. St. Teresa was a great leader and true lover of Jesus and his Church. She died in 1582 and was proclaimed a saint by Pope Gregory XV in 1622. She was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Paul VI in 1970.

*St. Teresa taught that we must have a great trust in God's care for us. She wrote that a person who possesses God, lacks nothing; God alone is enough.*

### Sample Questions for the Intergenerational Healing Service on Thursday, October 25

1. Is there someone living or dead that you have not forgive from the heart? Bless the person and not the crime.
  2. Do you need to receive forgiveness not just from God but from the living or dead? Do need to forgive them. This is not *necromancy* but intercessory prayer. Deceased (purgatory) may want to forgive you and you them but cannot reach you.
  3. Are you clinging to deceased person with morbid grief-prolonged grief? Need to "let go".
  4. Have you prayed for people before or after death? Not casual but sincere prayer.
  5. Have you prayed for abortions, stillbirths, miscarriages in your family?
  6. Which member of you family (living or dead) have you hurt the most or have hurt you?
  7. Which member of your family died without love: suicide, abortion, lonely death, accidents murder or perhaps they have lived in another country?
  8. Which members of your family, living or dead, have shown negative behavior problems such as drug or alcohol addiction, prejudice, rage, sexual problems, confusion, depression, oppression occult involvement?
  9. People predisposed to various types of sickness handed down thru the family tree such as cancer, diabetes, etc and psychological/psychiatric disorders?

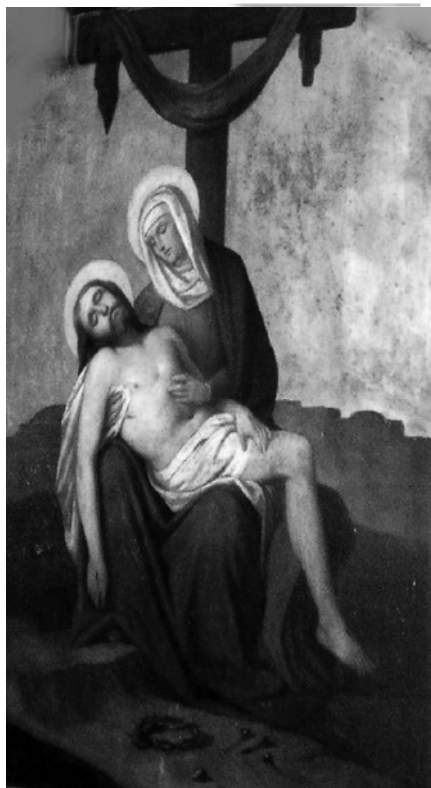

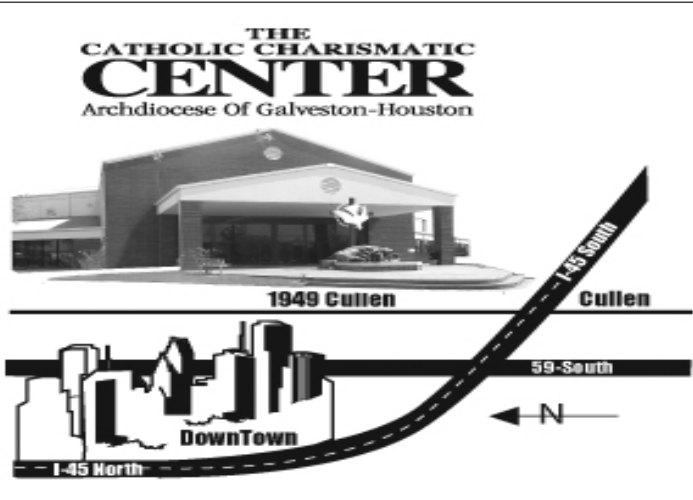

## Eventos de la Comunidad Hispana

### SEÑOR QUE NO SEAMOS SORDOS A TU VOZ

El evangelio de este domingo inicia con la petición que los apóstoles dirigen a Jesús: “Auméntanos la fe” ¿Cuántas veces nosotros estamos en esa situación? Ante las crisis originadas en el mundo de hoy en que todo parece inestable, la verdad, requerimos aumentar nuestra fe, pero ¿Cómo lograrlo? Esto no es como ir a una tienda a comprarla, no es de este modo, y al igual que los apóstoles que su fe se decaía ante las situaciones adversas que atravesaban, así igualmente sucede en nosotros, asistimos a la Iglesia, nos alimentamos con la palabra de Dios y la Eucaristía, pero... Cuando vienen los problemas (¿y quien esta libres de ellos?) pareciera que a la fe le salen alas y huye de nosotros cual grácil gacela.
