TOPIC: Walking with the Lord

GUARDIAN ANGELS

Through the eyes of faith, we have nine choirs of angels who help us in our walk with the Lord. Some of the angles are Holy Dominations, Holy Powers, Holy Thrones, Holy Principalities, Cherubim, Seraphim, Holy Virtues, and our Guardian Angles. We were invited to call upon the angles to help us get into the presence of God.

Revelations 21:1-7 - Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared...And I saw the holy city, the New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband...

We have the Holy Angels with us. Indeed, we stand with all the apostles, saints, martyrs, doctors of the church, the Mother of God, our Lady, and the long line of witnesses that have gone before us. May we have the grace to get outside of ourselves into the mind of Jesus. We pray for a deeper outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Fall upon us like a gentle breeze Holy Spirit.

Fr. Ed encouraged participants to pray in tongues and referred attendees to the book of Acts 2: When the day of Pentecost came Mother Mary and the apostles were gathered together in the upper room, and became changed men and women.

Word of Knowledge/Scriptures:

Love of God is eternal. God's love is compassionate, merciful and forgiving.

In time of darkness, be not afraid. When all is stripped away, focus on me. Let me be the center of your life. There is nothing to fear. Do not be afraid. I am God. I am in control. I will provide for you. You are not impoverished. You are a child of God.

God is setting marriages free.

John 6:33 & 40 – The true bread of God is the one that comes down from heaven and gives life to the world. For it is my Father's will that all those who see the Son and believe in Him have eternal life, and I will raise them on the last day.

Enter into my glory. I am here. Enter into my presence, my fire. I will purify you of everything. Don't be afraid. Whatever burden, sin there is, I can cleanse you. My fire does not destroy. It cleanses. I am the fire that gives life. I am limitless love. I am the Lord of love.

Acts 2: Peter gives discourse

My heart is glad. My flesh will dwell in hope. You have made known to me our path of life.

Acts 1: You will be my witnesses.

God is releasing us from bondage and healing us and our families. God can do the impossible. Be generous to family and friends. Pour out your intentions.

Let God use us in spite of ourselves.

Teaching: Walking with the Lord by Marsha Northland

Our Blessed Mother at Fatima urged us to prayer, penance and confession. When we commit sin, we need to do penance and make amends. We can do the morning offering to offer all our day, works, joys and trials in union with Jesus and all of the masses throughout the world. We can offer up the day and all we do as our penance. He begins to direct our footsteps.

We have Angels with us. We were in the throne of God with the Blessed Trinity in the presence of God. Prayer is contemplation, heart speaking to the heart. In Revelation, we have a description of heaven, where we will have fun, and no more crying, pain or illness.

When we walk with the Lord, our joy is our strength. Joy of the Lord. 1 Peter 1:3-9- Praise be to God. He gave us new birth. He will raise us from the death. Let our faith remain strong even when we may suffer many trials. Salvation is our destiny.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18- Dear friends, the truth is that we don't have to be sad and have no hope. For we believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead; and he will come again. We will be with the Lord.

Pull out your Sword and resist the enemy! Life can be hard, difficult at times and also joyful. He wants to be with us.

In our walk with the Lord, we need prayer. Take time to journal with the scriptures in the New Testament. Write down your thoughts. Holy Spirit is alive and speaks to us personally. Journaling is proof that God speaks to you. Reflect on the theme he is speaking about.

God dwells in us. He is merciful even when I sin. He is the creator, merciful and forgiving.

We walk in faith. Our Blessed Mother of Mount Carmel can intercede for us. Wear the scapular which is a sign of protection. There is power in the scapular and Satan hates her. Be my child. We belong to the Blessed Mother. Walk with the Lord and the Blessed Mother. Go back to the sacramentals, e.g. wear the miraculous medal and Carmelite scapular. Drink Lourdes holy water and light a candle.

Challenge for the month: Get back to the sacramentals. Wear the brown scapular and miraculous medal.
